NAVAIR STANDARDIZATION REPORT TO THE EIA CE 2.0 COMMITTEE

1. Conversion of existing military documents to SAE standards.

A. MIL-DTL-5015/SAE-AS50151 Electrical Connector specification. Comments from the coordination of cancellation of MIL-DTL-5015 and its associated specification and adoption of the corresponding SAE-AS50151 documents have been deferred by the commentor. I am in the process of dating the documents. The dated documents should be available in the ASSIST database by the end of October.

C. MS25189/SAE-AS25189 Terminal. The cancellation notice for MS25189 and the adoption notice for SAE-AS25189 have been dated and submitted to the ASSIST for publication.

D. MIL-C-22909/SAE-AS5259 and SAE-AS5259/1 Tool Specification. The group cancellation, adoption notices for SAE-AS5259 and AS5259/1 and coordination letter have been finalized and coordination will begin shortly after I return from travel.

E. SAE-AS39029/113 and /114 Contacts. The adoption notices for these two contacts have been dated and submitted to the ASSIST for publication.

F. MIL-C-81703/SAE-AS81703. Electrical Connectors. DoD project numbers have been assigned and a draft group cancellation notice and individual adoption notices are being prepared. I expect that coordination of these documents will begin sometime in November.

G. MIL-C-81582 and SAE-AS81582. Electrical connectors. Projects for the cancellation of MIL-C-81582 and associated specification sheets and adoption of the corresponding SAE documents are expected to begin shortly with coordination starting sometime in October.

2. QPL revisions and entering of data into the QPD. QPL-AS70991, QPL-AS7928, QPL-81511, QPL-81582, and QPL-81969 have been transitioned to the QPD since the last meeting. In addition, the data from QPL-AS29600 has been entered into the system and should be available from the ASSIST shortly. I have included a copy of the list of QPLs published in the database for inclusion in the minutes.

3. QPL-AS23190 (QPD). An issue has been encountered for some QPL-AS23190 manufacturers because the current QPL uses an asterisk to represent strap colors. DLA made an electronic buy of these straps and did not taking into account the parts that use the asterisk. As a result, some of the qualified manufacturers for MS3367 were not considered. The data in the QPD is in the process of being updated to replace the asterisks with the applicable color codes. To date the color codes for MS3367 have been added to the QPD.

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4. CAGE Codes. Thanks to all who have responded to my requests for CAGE codes. The registration of CAGE codes in CCR for all company addresses in QPLs that have either been entered into the QPD or that are in the process of being added continues to be important because the validation requirements to add or revise data in the QPD have recently changed. Currently, I am not able to add or update records/parts to the QPD for any companies who do not have active CAGE codes registered in CCR where their office and plant(s) are located at different addresses.
